

Applicants are required to submit three (3) letters of recommendation in support of each application submitted to the Graduate School. NO RECOMMENDATION FORMS ARE REQUIRED . . . HOWEVER IT IS UP TO THE APPLICANT TO CONTACT THE RECOMMENDER. Applicants are allowed to submit additional recommendations if desired.

Give careful consideration to each recommender that you select. These individuals should have personal knowledge of your academic qualifications; work related ethics; or experience interacting with you in a volunteer or community related activity.

Recommendations may be mailed directly to the appropriate Graduate School office by the recommenders, or given to the applicant to be included in their application packages. In both cases the recommendation must arrive in a sealed envelope and initialed on the back flap by the recommender.

The Graduate School also allows for receipt of electronic recommendations. Electronic recommendation letters should be written on university or business letterhead, include the recommender's signature, and contain contact information. The letter should be sent as an email attachment by the recommender to the appropriate campus office (Bowman Gray campus - bggrad@wfubmc.edu; Reynolda campus - gradschl@wfu.edu).
